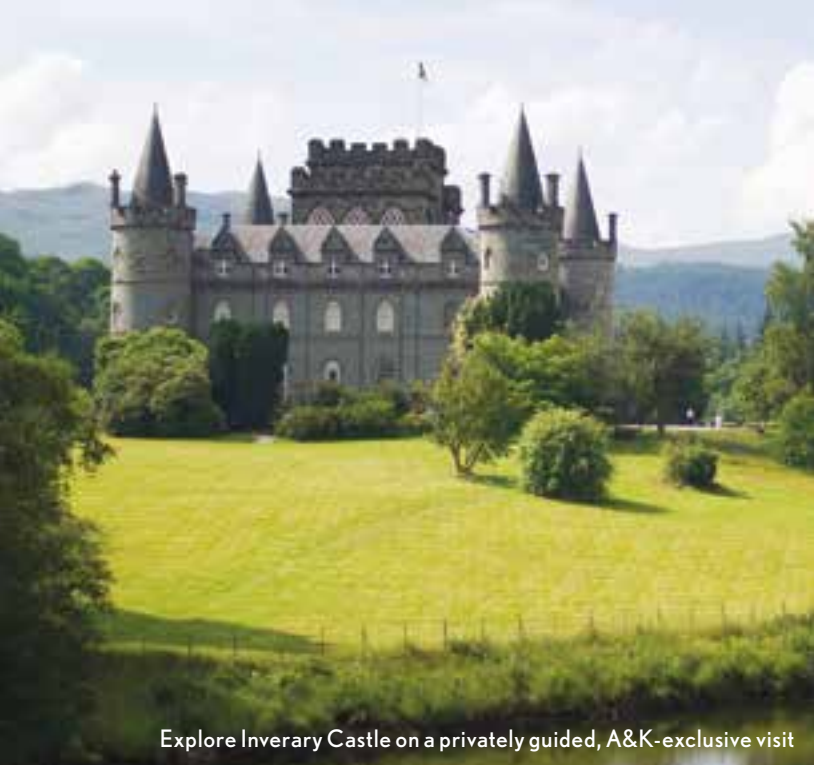
DAY 5: Dundee & St. Andrews | Scottish Innovation
