Arrabida: home of delicious wine, cheese and tiles



You'll start this exciting journey crossing the 25th of April Bridge and going straight to Azeitão located in the heart of Arrabida Mountain. You will be preparing your stomach for all the luxurious wine you will be tasting by trying the lip-smacking cheese of Azeitão. You will visit the old Dairy and cheese museum and taste cheese and the famous Muscatel wine.

Jose Maria da Fonseca is one of the oldest wine producer brands in Portugal, visiting this cellar you can get to know everything about the famous "muscatel" and even find why it is forbidden to kill spiders! You'll try 3 different wines and taste the legendary "Tortas de Azeitão" (the sweets from the region). You'll cross the Natural Park of Arrabida and look for the most hidden restaurant in the region, where you can sample many different dishes and a great gastronomy.

Now it's time to make a hard decision: *more wine or a tile-painting workshop?*

More wine? Let's go to another winery and taste different wines!

Do you feel more like tiles? You can visit an old tile-painting factory where you'll find out everything about tiles and will have the opportunity to paint a tile yourself, which can be shipped home!

At the end of the tour you'll go back to Lisbon by the Vasco da Gama Bridge, giving you the opportunity to cross both bridges.

What's included? An 8-hour private guided tour, cheese and muscatel tasting, 3 wines and 1 Torta de Azeitão at JMF Cellar, another wine tasting or 1 title painting workshop, & transportation.
