Evora and Cork Factory Tour!

Our local guide and chauffeur will pick you up at your hotel in a luxury minivan and head to Evora. Evora is a Portuguese city and one of the oldest in Europe. Across the region you will find the Alentejo, characterized by crops of cereals, pastures, forests of cork and oak, vineyards, olive groves and rice fields.



Here you will have a walk through the Old Town, visiting the Cathedral and the Chapel of Bones.

For lunch you will visit a wine cellar, where you will have a taste of some regional's extravagant wines and then a picnic among the vineyards.

After lunch, you will visit a farm. Here you can see thousands of trees and touch it. The Cork harvesting usually is done in the warmer months July and August so that the cork is dry and can be easily extracted from the trees. This spring has been very cold, so it is very difficult for a farmer to start collecting the cork in June as it has not been hot to do so.

Then, you will go to visit a Cork Factory, where you can learn how the cork is transformed and the whole process of manufacture.

After the visit you will return to Lisbon.
