

## Fatima and surroundings



You'll leave Lisbon and head to Fatima, where you'll visit the sanctuary. It is situated in the same place where in 1917, Our Lady appeared to three little shepherds, Francisco, Jacinta and sister Lucia. This is a day dedicated to your faith, so take your time to visit the sanctuary, pray, light a candle and/or pay your vows. You'll have as much free time as you want, and no one will rush you.

When you feel ready to leave, you'll visit the houses of the three shepherds, in Aljustrel. This is a little village close to Fatima.

After visiting the Fatima, we suggest you visit Obidos to complete your day. There you will have lunch in a local restaurant.

The medieval village of Obidos has narrow and beautiful flower streets, where you can taste the "Ginginha", *cherry liquor*.

**What's included?** An 8-hour private guided tour, 1 cup of Ginginha liquor, and transportation.

**What's not included?** Meals & drinks not mentioned, entrances fees, and souvenirs.
